**“Public Houses in American and How They Played a Part on Creating America”** by Bruce Stocking. Along the many roads that crisscrossed the rural Pennsylvania lansdscape in the early 19<sup>th</sup> century, a traveler would encounter a local “Public House”, also known as a Tavern & Inn. These establishments offered refreshments and accommodations to the traveler and served as gathering places for the local inhabitants to meet and deal in commerce. Mr. Stocking will discuss how the Public Houses served as rest stops and the economics of the early 1800s.
